Sensations

D - Dry

S - Smooth

L - Lubrication

Categories of Bleeding

H - Heavy Flow

M - Moderate Flow

L - Light Flow

VL - Very Light Flow

Categories of Dry*

0 - Dry

2 - Damp without lubrication

4 - Shiny without lubrication

2W - Wet without lubrication

*Dry = Dry or Smooth sensation when you wipe with nothing you can finger test on the tissue

Categories of Non-Peak Mucus

6 - 1/4" or less (Sticky)

8 - 1/2" - 3/4" (Tacky)

P - Pasty

C - Cloudy/white

G - Gummy/gluey

Y - Yellow

R - Red/pink

B- Brown

Categories of Peak Mucus

Finger-testable:

10 - 1" or more (Stretchy)

8 - 1/2" - 3/4" (Tacky) (8K; 8CK)

6 - 1/4" or less (6K; 6CK)

Nothing to finger-test:

10DL - Damp with lubrication 10SL - Shiny with lubrication 10WI - Wet with lubrication

Colour:

K - Crystal clear

C/K - Partly crystal clear

& partly cloudy

C - Cloudy/white

G - Gummy/gluey

B- Brown

Y - Yellow

R - Red/pink

*Note how many times you observed the "most fertile" sign on your chart at the end of each day: 1x, 2x, 3x, or AD (AD or all day = 4x or more)
